INTERNATIONAL POULTRY SCIENTIFIC FORUM PAST PARTICIPANT:

As a previous attendee, we invite you and other members of your organization to attend the 2009 International Poultry Scientific Forum, January 26-27 and the International Poultry Expo and International Feed Expo, January 28-30. All activities will be held at the Georgia World Congress Center, Atlanta, Georgia, USA. The Southern Poultry Science Society (SPSS) and the Southern Conference on Avian Diseases (SCAD) traditionally hold their meetings on the Monday and Tuesday preceding the Expo. Holding the forum during the same week as the Expo allows university and industry personnel to combine the scientific programs with industry-specific educational programs and the opportunity to view the latest products and services for the poultry and egg industry.

This year's pre-registration fee of \$50, allows you entrance into the International Poultry Scientific Forum AND the International Poultry Expo and International Feed Expo. This means you only have to register one time. Your Scientific Forum badge will get you into the International Poultry Expo and International Feed Expo. The \$50 fee can be charged to your Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover credit card. We encourage you to pre-register to avoid standing in line. Complete the enclosed pre-registration form and return to USPOULTRY no later than December 26. ***Onsite registration fee is US\$65.*** We do not accept checks on site. Badges will be mailed to each individual registrant to the address submitted on your registration form. So please ensure this is the address your badge should be mailed to. Online registration will be available September 29 at www.ipe09.org. There will be a \$5 charge for printing a lost or replacement badge on site.

Nearly 900 companies will exhibit at the Expo, displaying equipment and supplies used in the production, processing, packaging and marketing of poultry products. Representatives will be present to discuss the latest technology for you and your company.
